Recycle Week 2025 begins on Monday 22nd September 2025 and will run throughout next week. This year's theme is '*Rescue Me, Recycle*', and we are excited to share the activities our academy has planned to inspire pupils and the wider school community:

- **Community Litter Pick** Selected children will form the Birley Brigade and head into the local area for a community clean-up. After our litter pick, we will sort the litter out into both recyclable and non-recyclable items and dispose of it appropriately.
- Creative Recycling Competition Children will be invited to design or create something
