



Monday 3rd March - Wednesday 5th March



On the day

- Arrive in the hall with your case (we will confirm the time closer to the date but this will be around 8:30am)
- Children say goodbye in the hall
- No packed lunch is needed
- Tags must be attached to the cases (these will be given to children prior to the 4th March)
- Children should bring a water bottle for the journey and to refill at Robinwood.
- We aim to arrive back on Wednesday at 4:20 but we will provide updates for this
- Children must be collected from Hayfield - they cannot walk home

What to pack?

Please refer to clothing list.

- It will be cold when we are there so please ensure children have layers, hats and gloves.
- Bottoms are best with tracksuits rather than leggings due to the nature of the activities.
- Robinwood provide wellies and waterproofs so it is not necessary to pack these.
- Names in EVERYTHING! Laundered and returned so needs to find its way back.
- Opportunities for showers
- Please pack with children so they know what is in their bag as they will be expected to pack themselves when leaving
- Sensible trainers - not canvas (2 pairs ideally)

Luggage and journey

- A small wheelie case is ideal (cabin case).
 - Holdalls are fine
 - The children carry/wheel to Hayfield Crescent then carry to their rooms
 - No sweets. Zero tolerance of food in rooms due to allergies and choking.

- On arrival, we have a couple of miles to walk to get to the centre
 - Their coat must be worn to travel and strong (ideally waterproof) trainers

What not to pack...

- Mobile Phones
- Cameras
- Computer games
- iPads/tablets
- iPods/MP3 players/speakers
- fitbits/apple watches/smart watches
- bedding
- aerosol sprays - roll on deodrant is fine



Robinwood operate a zero tolerance policy on any of the electrical items and phones.

Behaviour and Expectations

- Robinwood have their own behaviour policy with high expectations of all children.
- Not following this can result in children missing out on activities as safety is paramount and children misbehaving/not listening to instructions may compromise their own safety and that of others.
- If children are frequently misbehaving then parents will be contacted and will need to collect them.
- Day staff and night staff at Robinwood are there to ensure that everybody has a fantastic time and in order for this to happen it is important that rules are followed and behaviour is good.

Behaviour and Expectations

- Each group has a member of our staff to encourage children and help to remind them of the expectations.
- We have mixed day time groups with a familiar adult with them at all times as well as a group leader who is a qualified instructor
- Robinwood night staff are on duty with two school staff on call each night
- Please make sure the points of contact that you have given are available for calls during the time we are away

Medicine

- Forms need returning back to school asap with the medicine
- Any travel sickness medication will need to be added to a form as well. You will give this to your child on the morning of Monday 4th and we will give it to them on the Wednesday
- Please ensure any medication is labelled with your child's name
- Preventer inhalers need a form
- Reliever inhalers in their pocket on the day - please bring a spare one into school asap
- Calpol letters need signing - spare tonight if you still need to complete one
