

Daily Reading

Please share the book that is sent home from school. These are changed once a week, You could also read any books you have at home.

Phonics

This half term we are revisiting the phonemes taught in Spring 1. We will be teaching children to read longer words. You can help by getting your child to learn the tricky words and phonemes sent to you previously.

Communication & Language

Children need to be able to use different tenses when they talk. You can help by talking about things from the past that they remember such as a holiday, outing or birthday.

<u>Life Skills</u>

Children need to be able to manage their own dressing and undressing. From underwear through t-shirt, trousers and jumper to coat, hat and gloves children should be able to dress themselves without adult help. Spend time this term encouraging your child to get better at dressing and undressing.

Understanding the World

We will be thinking about transport and where it can take us. You can help by sharing photos of places you have been and talking about how you travelled there. You could use a globe, map or google earth to show how far away it is.

<u>Writing</u>

We have been working on thinking of a sentence to go with a picture then writing it. You can help by getting your child to draw a picture then think of a sentence then write. You might need to help with the sounding out of words in the sentence.

Expressive arts and design

As we move into spring we will be looking at flowers and plants. You could encourage your child to draw the things they see on a spring walk or make an Easter chick.

<u>Maths</u>

We will be continuing to learn the numbers up to 20. We are learning to find one more and one less than a number. Write the numbers to ten in order then ask your child to say what is one more or less.

Maps and Globes

If you are planning a holiday or day out then use a map or globe to show your child where they will be going. Talk about how you will get there and how long it might take.
